## **A.X.E. CLOSE PROTECTION TRAINING FOR MILITARY & SPECIALIST LAW ENFORCEMENT.**

The **A.X.E.** Close Protection ( **PSD** ) syllabus incorporates the following '*Active-Defense*' programs :

- A.X.E.** Team Formation, and *Actions On Drills*.  
Security Escort and Anti-Ambush drills.
- C.A.R.** Firearms Training. (*all modes*) Immediate Close Quarters Engagements.
- C.R.O.P.s** Planning for Close Protection ( **PSD** ) Operations.

The above three Syllabuses are separate modules in their right. Taught over a five or ten day program. Designed to form the '*Active-Defense*' intensive course. These modules have been broken down to *Three* separate stages.

The Instructor for the course is Paul Castle. Paul served on HRH. The Queen's 2SG Protection Team over a period of three years. He has since trained Close Protection Teams of the British Army RMP. in the **C.A.R.** firearms. Other Instructors have elite Military backgrounds.

He has also trained with RM. Units in Germany, and German Special Forces in Berlin, in relation to vehicle anti-ambush, and counter firearms assault. He has also conducted training for members of the RUC E4B Teams.

He has taught Close Protection Training ( **PSD** ) to various *Students* in Central Europe, and is currently training numerous Special Operations Specialists. In 2002/5 he taught Close Protection to *Peel Regional SWAT* in Toronto, Canada, and RCMP HQ ERT on aircraft defense / counter assault.

In 2004/5 courses were taught to USN SRT Team Members in Greece, and USA Oil Company Security Teams. In 2006 at the National Training Center FT. Irwin he taught Units ( *50 Personnel* ) of US 11th Cav in Tactical Firearms, Counter Ambush, and PSD duties. Paul is currently *State* and *Federally* licensed to handle and use explosive materials. He is a DOD TPIN & DUNNS registered Government Contractor.

### A.X.E. Team Formation, and Escort Drills.

This module trains *Military Specialists* in *High Risk* PSD both V.I.P and Category “A” Principal’s by Land, Sea, or Air.

Students should be in possession of all issued Firearms, Batons, and Chemical Irritants. Uniform or plain cloths may be worn. Plain cloths Students should bring concealed holster systems.

- ◇ Students should be fully equip to undertake 12 hour training periods, have suitable clothing for all weather scenario’s, and have sufficient food and beverages to sustain them for 24 hours.
- ◇ Students should bring to the course 500 rounds for Carbines, and Pistols. Munitions can supplied by Sabre Tactical Training Resource.
- ◇ Military ACU’s / Body armor should be worn at all times where practicable, \*\* unless plain cloths scenario.
- ◇ This course will have flexible start and finish times during its five day duration. Students should assume that the course is a 5 day 24 hour per day training mission involving live training scenarios. There will be evening work, and this school will be demanding.
- ◇ Fully bound manuals are provided to each Student for study, review, and practice. Each module is fully certified. Building towards the final certification of **Tactical Firearms & Close Protection Specialist**.
