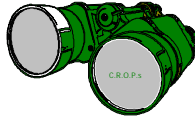

## C.R.O.P.s & TACTICAL RAID PLANNING



### C.R.O.P.s

#### *Covert Reconnaissance and Observation Planning System*

**C.R.O.P.s** enables the *Student* to provide detailed and accurate information of buildings with regard to external and internal layouts or outside locations that may be subject of a '*High Risk*' Action. This will include School building exodus scenarios in the event of any *Active - Shooter* scenarios.

This course utilizes methods designed and implemented by *Special Forces* and *Covert Units*. Taught for a *Law Enforcement* application, this unique system can be easily understood and implemented quickly and effectively. This System will not assist *Non-Departmental* Personnel if communications are being monitored by a *hostile* force.

The course trains '*First Response*' Personnel to deploy at a '*Major Incident*' Location, and tasked with the setting up an initial 'Incident Command and Control Point.' **C.R.O.P.s** techniques enable almost instant mapping, and location identification of any 'Hostile Suspects.'

This system can be deployed by *Air Support Surveillance Units* controlling ground personnel. **C.R.O.P.s** enables a wounded *Officer* to direct assistance to his/her location without verbal communication, using only radio 'Click' signals. The **C.R.O.P.s** System develops stealth tactics for placing *Operatives* into '*Concealed Cover Positions*' in order to carry out *Covert Surveillance* and intelligence gathering.

### ***The Syllabus includes :***

- ◇ Incident command structures.
- ◇ Collation and dissemination of information.
- ◇ Tactical planning for *High Risk S.W.A.T.*
- ◇ High risk building entry planning.
- ◇ V.I.P. security protection duties.
- ◇ Covert observation and evidence gathering.
- ◇ Suspect / injured Officer location techniques.

This is a 24 hour, three day course, involving both *Class Room*, and *Out Door* activities. \*\* see lesson plan.

Students are required to be in possession of '*Out Doors*' clothing, M.R.E. meals types, and associated equipment to sustain themselves for up to a 24 hour operational period.

**Duty weapons should be available. No live ammo required.**
