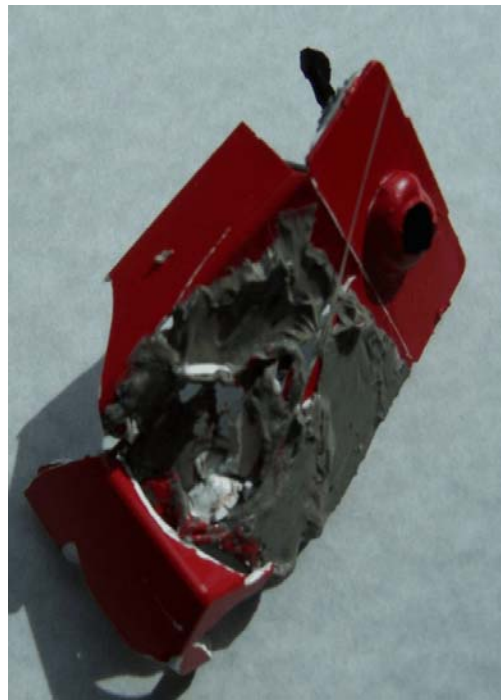


TESTING AND EVALUATIONS

In order to test the safety aspects of the *Armadillo* and *Scimitar* breaching charges on the 18th September 2008 at Mount Pleasant MI. nine members of a Police Sniper class, attended by the State of MI. DOC Ordnance Training Section, and the local SWAT Team simultaneously fired 8 rounds of .308 and one round of .223 at 50 yards, into a fully functional device.



There was no *dangerous reaction* or *ignition* of the energetic filler. The above pictures are of the damaged remains of the body. As a result of these and other tests we have carried out, we contend that when handled correctly, and used as instructed on our training courses, the breaching devices are *reliable* and *safe* to use as a tactical breaching device.
