IMPROVISED EXPLOSIVE DEVICE RECOGNITION BOOBY TRAPS AND DIRTY BOMBS

The *Terrorist* use of explosive devices is well known and very well documented. From Iran to Ireland to Oklahoma. It is a simple and relatively safe method of achieving an objective. The *explosive device* can be easily concealed, and constructed to explode by a wide variety of initiation methods.



There is a plethora of information now available through books, as well as the *Internet* on how to construct a bomb, and more importantly how to mix and manufacture the explosive materials themselves, from *over-the-counter* ingredients. The basic aim of this training course is to give an insight into I.E.D.s Booby Traps, and basic so called *Dirty Bombs*. This course is includes restricted information for Military, Law Enforcement S.W.A.T. and Patrol Personnel only. *This one day (eight hour) course covers :*

- ☑ *What to look for. / How they work.*
- ☑ *How they can be constructed.*
- ☑ *How they can be initiated.*
- ☑ *How to implement and then conduct a search.*
- ☑ *Preparations to assist ATO's.*
- ☑ *Evacuation drills.*

This training course does not make you an instant E.O.D / A.T.O., but it could save your life. If you find an *I.E.D.* call out an *Expert*.

Students are requested to bring with them full tactical gear. Body armor if they possess it, and BDU or working uniform. They will be required to wear eye protection, and have additional ear protection for certain demonstrations of the effects of I.E.D.'s.

This program will be undertaken as a classroom training session, followed by *hands on* outside training, inside buildings, with *live deployment* of various I.E.D. munitions, and live detonation of low level training devices. Sabre Tactical Instructors are *Federally* and *State* explosive licensed.

** Students will require to be self sufficient for inclement weather, and should bring food and water to sustain them for an eight hour period. The use of small mirrors may be an advantage. Students should also provide sterile gloves, and protective overalls if they have them. In essence clothing suitable for searching the underneath of vehicles, roofs and floor spaces.

COURSE OVERVIEW

0800 hours. Commencement of course with Introduction to the makeup of I.E.D.'s. How they are deployed, and what they can do to the Victims, and any responding Tactical Team.

0900 hours. Safety issues and procedures.

1000 hours. I.E.D. construction, and recognition training.

1100 hours. C.R.O.P.s system for deployment during critical scenario's.

1200 hours. Lunch period

1245 hours. Resumption of course.

1300 hours. Live hands on search deployment (at range and NCLETTTC)

1530 hours. Course review, examinations.

1600 hours Course conclusion. Graduation.
